Inviting Gender-Based Violence Professionals to Discuss the Role of the Coordinator of Domestic Violence

APOSTOLI is launching an invitation to gender-based violence and social services professionals. It is planned that 3 working groups will be formed in each partner country to prepare the discussion on the role of the **Domestic Violence Coordinator (DVC)**. Social workers, social trainers, psychologists, coroners are among the professionals who are invited to participate in the working groups.

Groups will meet in at least two separate sessions each, the outcomes of which, will support the development of a questionnaire to be answered by social sector staff and specialists, who, by the nature of their profession, they work with victims of violence against women and girls (focus groups). Feedback of the questionnaire will define the role, profile and training needs of the professionals who wish to be accredited as DVC. A common questionnaire will be used in all four partner countries to ensure credibility and homogeneity of approach at a European level.

The opinion of focus groups' specialists will be a major point of reference for the definition and elaboration of the thematic modules of the teaching manual, the creation of a visual support for teaching, and the elaboration of training materials that will ensure interaction and practical application of knowledge.
